

Covid-19 safety guidelines BAK, basis voor actuele kunst, Utrecht

In order to make your visit at BAK as safe and pleasant as possible, please note that BAK has drafted some guidelines according to the RIVM and government measures. Please help us to make sure BAK and other cultural institutions can stay open by following these guidelines:

To keep in mind before you visit BAK:

- If you show any Covid-19 related symptoms, such as a cold, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, a light cough, or high temperature (up to 38 C°), please make sure to stay at home, and let us know you are not coming, so we can free up your seats.
- Only people with a pre-booked ticket for a specific program, a booked timeslot for an exhibition (via Eventbrite), or a pre-booked spot on the guest list will be let in. There are no extra tickets available at the door.
- Please note there is no bar at BAK and no smoking area.
- The lockers and coat racks are not in use at the moment. Please do not bring large bags, and when at BAK, keep your coat/small bag with you.

During your visit:

- We strongly advise wearing a face mask.
- Please disinfect your hands with the disinfectant provided near the entrance.
- Please keep 1.5m distance to others at all times, also when waiting in line.
- Show your ticket at the reception desk, or provide your name if you are on the guest list.
- Payment is pin-only.
- If you grab a copy of any printed material, please keep it with you.
- In some places, there is one-way traffic: please follow the indicated signs.
- In some spaces, there is a maximum amount of people allowed inside at one time. This will be posted near the space in question. Kindly wait outside if the space is at full capacity.
- There are two guest toilets at BAK. Please turn the green sign to red if you enter, so people outside know it is occupied. Please wash your hands with soap after visiting the toilet.
- Cough and sneeze in the inside of your elbow. Use paper towels and dispose of them after use.
- Please follow the directions of the BAK staff at all times.
