**Slow Viewing: A *Fragments of Repair/Kader Attia* One-Day Residency
18 April–1 August 2021**

BAK, basis voor actuele kunst, Utrecht offers the possibility to engage with *Fragments of Repair/Kader Attia* in a focused and slower-paced manner. Single-day residencies are offered to individuals or households (up to two participants) who are interested in engaging with the constellation of works on view within a different scale of time and concentration. The exhibition presents a variety of video, collage, and sculptural objects by Attia that grapple with overlapping and urgent issues, such as architecture as a form of social and psychological control, mental health care from a decolonial perspective, and restitution. The residency is open to one individual/household per day.
